Should I use k-means or hierarchical clustering? K-Means works well for globular cluster shapes with similar sizes. Hierarchical suits hierarchical data and can handle varied shapes. DBSCAN handles noise better and doesn't need the number of clusters specified. Consider data characteristics to select the optimal clustering technique.

Why is hierarchical clustering better? Hierarchical clustering has a couple of key benefits: There is no need to pre-specify the number of clusters. Instead, the dendrogram can be cut at the appropriate level to obtain the desired number of clusters. Data is easily summarized/organized into a hierarchy using dendrograms.

Which hierarchical clustering method is best? Based on these findings, Ward's method is the best choice for clustering functional data, particularly when there are periodic tendencies in the data. Average linkage is recommended if the suspected clustering structure has one or two very large groups, particularly when the data are not periodic.
