What are the indications for ocular B scan ultrasonography? Media opacity - In such conditions, B scan helps us in gathering better anatomical information when media opacity eludes a simple clinical examination. Posterior segment pathologies through opaque media eg, dense cataract, bleeding in the eye.

What is B-scan biometry used for? A B-scan is generally used to evaluate diseases involving the posterior segment (the hind two-third of the eye) and orbit, typically when the ocular media (fluids within the eye) are cloudy and a direct visualization is not possible.

What is the B-scan for? B scan, or Bright Scan ultrasonography is a diagnostic imaging tool utilized when the view to the back of the eye, or posterior segment is hindered. The posterior segment of the eye is the back two-thirds of the eye and consists of the vitreous, retina, optic nerve, and choroid.

What is the role of B-scan in ocular trauma? B scan can be an extremely useful tool in management of ocular trauma, in presence of hazy media and when posterior segment pathologies such as foreign body, avulsion of optic nerve, retinal tear, retinal detachment, vitreous haemorrhage, vitreous detachment, proliferative retinopathy, perforation of sclera etc.

What is the difference between OCT and B-scan? Both methods can detect the membrane and a cystoid macular edema. However, retinal analysis with the optical coherence tomography is more precise. It can even detect cysts of the macular oedema or serous sub-foveal retinal detachment.

What is the difference between an A-scan and B scan ultrasound eye? An A-scan ultrasound measures the eye to determine the right power of a lens implant before cataract surgery. A B-scan is done to look at the inside part of the eye or the space around and behind the eye (orbit) that cannot be seen directly.

What are the contraindications for B-scan? Important contraindications to B-scan ultrasonography include scleral laceration and suspected ocular globe rupture (open globe) in patients with trauma or recent ocular surgery, because the procedure may result in the extrusion of ocular contents [11–14].

Choroidal detachments are domed shaped and are serous or hemorrhagic and often extend anteriorly toward the ciliary body, versus retinal detachments that are usually demarcated most anteriorly at the ora serrata.

What is the diagnostic test for ocular trauma? Ultrasonography: B-scan ultrasound is an important investigation to detect intraocular and intraorbital damage, especially when ocular media is not clear. B-scan can be used to visualize vitreous hemorrhage, retinal detachment, intraocular foreign bodies, damage to the extraocular muscles, and scleral rupture.

What are the indications for eye ultrasound? Indications. The most prevalent use of ocular ultrasonography is to obtain globe length in order to calculate corrective intraocular lens power requirements. Other uses include the measurement of tumors including choroidal melanomas, visualization of lens dislocation, and detection of retinal detachment.

What are the indications for OCT imaging? The indications of OCT include posterior segment lesions like the detection of fluid within the retinal layers or under the retina (which may not be visible clinically),³ macular holes, pseudoholes, epiretinal membranes (ERMs), vitreo-macular adhesion (VMA), vitreo-macular traction (VMT), retinoschisis, retinal ...

What is the standard for partial discharge testing? IEC 60270 – High-voltage test techniques – Partial discharge measurements is a general standard that defines the broad lines of partial discharge (PD) measurement in electrical apparatus. It is applicable for electrical measurements of PD using alternating voltages up to 400 Hz and direct voltage.

How do you test for partial discharge? Using an airborne ultrasonic microphone is the most sensitive way to detect PD where there is an air path between the source and the microphone. Contact ultrasonic sensors can be used for sealed chambers. -PD generates Transient Earth Voltages (TEV) – high frequency electromagnetic pulses.

What is partial discharge of cables? Partial Discharge - A flashover of part of the insulation system due to a localized electric field greater than the dielectric withstand capability of that part where the overall insulation system remains capable of withstanding the applied electrical field.

What is partial discharge in high voltage equipment? Partial discharge (PD) happens when a small area of insulation in a high voltage environment cannot cope with the electrical stress and breaks down. It doesn't span the whole distance between two insulated electrodes – that's why it's called 'partial'.

What is partial discharge standard IEC? IEC 60270 – partial discharge measurements (previously high voltage test techniques) – is applicable to the measurement of partial discharge which occurs in electrical apparatus, systems, and components when tested with DC voltage or AC voltage up to 400 Hz.

What is partial discharge test IEC 60664-1? According to standards IEC 60664-1 and IEC 61800-5-1, a transformer passes the partial discharge test if the charge of the stray capacitances is less than 10 pC during the measurement period. Fig. 3 shows the measurement of the charge of the stray capacitances during the partial discharge test.

What is the limit of partial discharge test? As per the standard IEC 60664-1, the device is considered to have passed the partial discharge test if the charge on the stray capacitances as depicted in Figure 4, is less than 10pC during the measurement period.

What is the instrument for partial discharge measurement? The MPD 800 measures partial discharge in compliance with the IEC 60270 standard to ensure the reliable detection of PD activity in instrument transformers.

What is the range of partial discharge? The partial discharge intensity measurement ranges from 2 pC to 50,000 pC (IEC 60 270) and radio interference voltage measurement ranges from 1 V to 25,000 mV (VDE, CISPR).

What is basic partial discharge? Introduction to Partial Discharge Partial discharge occurs when electrical insulation in high-voltage environments deteriorates under stress, leading to insulation failure. Although PD events are small, their impact over time can be significant, potentially leading to equipment failure and safety hazards.

What are the different types of partial discharge? PD can be classified into 3 main types: Internal PD, occurring inside insulation. Surface PD, tracking across insulation. Corona PD, from a sharp electrode into gas.

What defects lead to partial discharge? Mechanical damage: Physical damage to the insulation system can create voids or cracks that can lead to partial discharges. Ageing and deterioration: Over time, insulation materials can degrade due to exposure to heat, moisture, and other factors. This can lead to partial discharges.

How do you detect partial discharge? Partial discharge emits sound in the ultrasonic frequency range. With a high-sensitivity acoustic imaging camera, such as the Fluke ii910 Precision Acoustic Imager, you can detect and precisely locate partial discharge.

Is partial discharge the same as arcing? Partial discharge currents tend to be of short duration and have rise times in the nanosecond realm. On an oscilloscope, the discharges appear as evenly spaced burst events that occur at the peak of the sinewave. Random events are arcing or sparking.

What is the difference between partial discharge and electrical discharge? “Partial discharge (PD) is a localized electrical discharge that only partially bridges the insulation between conductors and which may or may not occur adjacent to a conductor.” PD occurs whenever there is a stressed region due to some impurity/cavity inside the insulation or when there is a protrusion outside it.

What is a partial discharge test in cables? The purpose of partial discharge testing of MV/HV cables is to find the discharge before it leads to flashover and catastrophic failure. Once PD starts, it will always grow until the insulation fails. This FAQ discusses testing of cables such as XLPE, EPR and PILC.

What is the purpose of partial discharge? Partial Discharge Testing plays a critical role in determining the health of your electrical assets and ensuring maximum uptime. It also provides asset managers with the critical information to target maintenance resources to the areas that require the most attention.

What is the apparent charge of a partial discharge? The apparent charge (q) of a PD event is not the actual amount of charge changing at the PD site. Instead, it is the change in charge that, if injected between the terminals of the device under test, would change the voltage across the terminals by an amount equivalent to the PD event.

What is the value of partial discharge test? What Parameters are Typically Measured During a Partial Discharge Test? Pulse Charge: Partial discharge pulses characteristically have rise times that are $1\mu\text{s}$ in liquid dielectrics and 1 ns in solid dielectrics.

What is the IEC 60664 standard? IEC 60664 is an international standard titled "Insulation coordination for equipment within low-voltage systems." It provides guidelines and requirements for the insulation coordination of electrical equipment in low-voltage systems to ensure the safe and reliable operation of electrical installations.

What is the inception voltage of partial discharge? In IEC TR 61294 is also defined the Partial Discharge Inception Voltage (PDIV) as the lowest value at which at least only one partial discharge occurs of an apparent charge equal to or exceeding 100 pC , when the oil sample is tested under some specified conditions.

What is the limit of partial discharge test? As per the standard IEC 60664-1, the device is considered to have passed the partial discharge test if the charge on the stray capacitances as depicted in Figure 4, is less than 10pC during the measurement period.

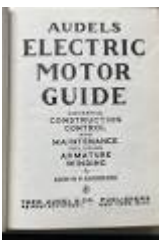
