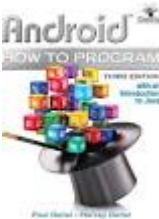

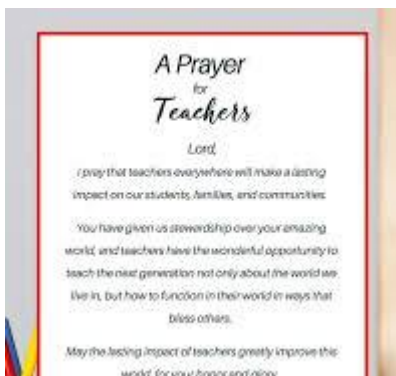


Figure 19 Powerful Prayers for Teachers (with Free Printable) -

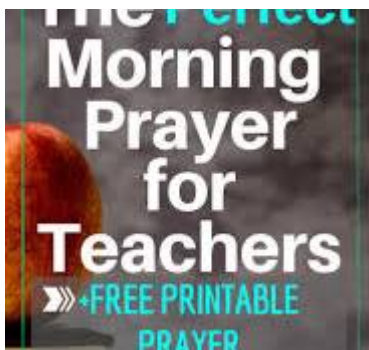

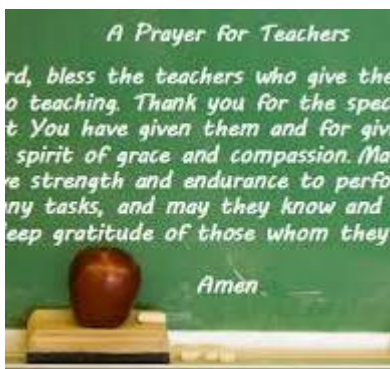

How many Beethoven piano sonatas are there? But if “masterpiece” can be meaningless, Beethoven's 32 piano sonatas, composed between 1795 and 1822, are deservedly touchstones. Hans von Bülow, the first to play all 32 in a series of recitals, likened Bach's “Well-Tempered Clavier” to the Old Testament and Beethoven's sonatas to the New.
