How to tell the year of Arctic Cat ATV? The VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) is a serial number used to identify an individual vehicle. The VIN for each vehicle is unique. The 10th character in the 17-character VIN represents the vehicle model-year.

How much oil does a Arctic Cat ATV take? Fill the engine with 10W-40 ATV oil. NOTE: If your Arctic Cat Alterra 500 has an automatic transmission, fill the engine with 2.6 quarts of oil. For an Arctic Cat Alterra 500 with a manual transmission, fill the engine with 3.5 quarts of oil. Step 9.

How do I tell what year my ATV is? Read the tenth digit. This digit represents the year that the ATV was made. For example, A=1980, B=1981, Y=2000, 1=2001, 9=2009 and A=2010. This letter or number can repeat (the "A," for example), but the codes of the other digits in the VIN allow you to know in which year the ATV was made.

Doug E. : On the earlier Cats, the number is XXXXX the front left wheel on the lower frame tube. On later models they moved it to the rear.

What year is 0 in VIN? The North American implementation of the VIS uses the 10th digit to encode the model year of the vehicle. Besides the three letters that are not allowed in the VIN itself (I, O and Q), the letters U and Z and the digit 0 are not used for the model year code. Outside North America the 10th digit is usually 0.

What is Edgar Allan Poe's The Black Cat about? 'The Black Cat' is the story of an alcoholic who is driven by his addiction. He tortures and kills his cat, Pluto. Then, a stray cat that looks almost exactly like the cat he murdered except for a gallows mark on its chest follows him home and drives him to become even more irrationally violent.

What is the message of The Black Cat? "The Black Cat" can be read as a temperance tale, a story that warns of the disastrous effect alcohol can have on a person's life and the happiness of their household. The story explores how alcoholism causes the narrator to behave like the tyrant of his household, caring only for his own needs and emotions.

What does The Black Cat story symbolize? The Black Cat Themes Justice and truth: The narrator tries to hide the truth by walling up his wife's body but the voice of the black cat helps bring him to justice. Superstition: The black cat is an omen of bad luck, a theme that runs throughout literature.

What are the major conflicts in The Black Cat? In "The Black Cat" the central conflict is the narrator fighting against his own violent and abusive impulses and the supernatural aspect of the cat's presence after its death. In this sense, the story is an example of what's known as "man against himself."

What is the hidden message of The Black Cat? The narrator closes up his wife and, accidentally, the second black cat behind a wall, symbolizing how he attempts to repress his guilt. With his wife hidden and the cat out of sight, he is able to sleep through the night, no longer tormented with reminders of how he destroyed his entire happy household.

What is the problem in The Black Cat by Edgar Allan Poe? Edgar Allan Poe's story, "The Black Cat," is a tale of violence and an internal battle with alcoholism. The narrator starts off loving animals and his wife, but unfortunately turns to alcohol and starts abusing his wife and animals, sparing only a black cat: Pluto.

What is ironic about the ending of The Black Cat? He thinks he has got away with murder, but in the end, one learns that he had accidentally buried the cat alive with his wife. The cat reveals his hiding spot when he is caught by the police.

What is the moral of the short story The Black Cat? More than any of Poe's stories, "The Black Cat" illustrates best the capacity of the human mind to observe its own deterioration and the ability of the mind to comment upon its own destruction without being able to objectively halt that deterioration.

What is the allegory in The Black Cat? Specifically, "The Black Cat" functions as a racial allegory that depicts the injustices of slavery and, ultimately, shows how slavery damns the South.

Is The Black Cat based on a true story? The plot essentially retells the short story in a semi-autobiographical manner, with Poe himself undergoing a series of events involving a black cat which he used to inspire the story of the same name.

What happened at the end of The Black Cat? The story ends when the police find the dead body of the man's wife, with the cat on her head. On the one hand it's outrageous, and even funny. At the same time, when we think about just how close these details can come to our own reality, it's sad and frightening. There is always some bizarre tragedy in the news.

Fueled by alcohol and despair, he fell into "fits of absolute unconsciousness"—and yet managed to write some of his greatest masterpieces, including "The Black Cat," which ...

What is the main theme of The Black Cat? The main themes in The Black Cat are guilt, madness, and alcohol abuse. Guilt: The narrator is consumed by guilt, which leads him to commit increasingly horrific acts.

What mental illness does The Black Cat have? Edgar Allan Poe's The Black Cat Essay The mental illness of paranoia was not given its name until the twentieth century. The narrator in "The Black Cat" becomes increasingly unstable as the story progresses, due to his excessive drinking and resulting guilt.

What is the major conflict in The Black Cat? The central conflict in “The Black Cat” is man versus himself. The narrator's descent into madness is signposted frequently by his irrational behavior, his justification of that behavior and assigning the blame to others (including the cat), his torturing animals, and his murdering his wife.

What does alcohol symbolize in The Black Cat? One of these functions is as a symbol of the narrator's guilt. Once the protagonist has embarked on his path of alcohol-fueled rage, the sight of Pluto fills him with guilt and self-loathing. The protagonist attacks Pluto, which only deepens his guilt. In the final act of the story, the protagonist murders his wife.

What happened to the narrator's wife in The Black Cat? The wife of the narrator of "The Black Cat," she shares his love of animals and fills their house with pets. Though she sticks by the narrator despite his abuse and murder of Pluto, their cat, the narrator ultimately kills her after she stops him from kill the second black cat that mysteriously appears in their life.

What English level is Frankenstein?

What is the setting of Frankenstein? There are four main settings in Frankenstein: Geneva, Ingolstadt, Walton's boat in the Arctic Ocean, and the home of the De Lacey family. In the novel, Geneva's familiar beauty represents for Victor Frankenstein the comfort and peacefulness of the natural world.

What is the theme of Frankenstein? In this case, Shelley explores the possibility of creating life from dead bodies. The novel suggests that while creating life in this way might be possible, it is also potentially very dangerous. New uses of technology can be destructive and dangerous if not handled carefully, a theme still relevant in today's society.

Mary Shelley wrote Frankenstein as part of a writing challenge between herself, her husband, her step-sister, Lord Byron, and John Polidori. She was also inspired by real experiments that she had seen and her own experiences of motherhood.

What 3 books does Frankenstein read? The monster reads Milton's Paradise Lost, portions of Plutarch's Lives, and Goethe's Sorrows of Young Werther.

Victor's pursuit of knowledge has taken him outside the boundaries of the scientific community, cost him his family, and murdered his wife.

Frankenstein's Monster is arguably considered one of the most tragic villains in history, as he was shunned since the very first moment he came to life, ostracized and rejected despite his good intentions, was repeatedly deprived of love and affection, and he became murderous solely to avenge his misery, but he ...

What is the level of narration in Frankenstein? In Mary Shelley's Frankenstein, we might distinguish three frame sequences: a reading sequence, an action sequence, and a narrative sequence. The narrative sequence is the primary, enabling frame shaping the novel, and is dependent upon three levels of narrative refiguring: rhetorical, elemental, and intentional.

What Lexile is Grade 7 reading? In the 7th grade, studies using a national sample of students have shown that typically readers will score at a Lexile level between 735L and 1065L over the course of the year. Growth of around 69L is generally achievable for 7th graders should students be progressing at around 1.3L per week.

Which is better to read Dracula or Frankenstein? I did enjoy the discussion and depictions of the natural surroundings and geography of the settings in both books. I feel like Dracula had a little more action than Frankenstein, but Frankenstein was a little more dramatic and emotional. I think I felt more for the characters in Frankenstein.

Is Frankenstein still worth reading? The novel is technically excellent Even now, typing this, Shelley's description of the protagonist's declining mental state sticks with me. The literary merits of this work go beyond its character work. Shelley's prose is deeply readable, even impressively so for a book that's over two centuries old.

Can a 14 year old read Frankenstein? If you do give it to a 14 year old, read it yourself first and be prepared to discuss the dark and violent themes. If your young person is not an easy talker, I would say no. Elizabeth It has a very graphic rape scene that disturbed me greatly. I did read the whole series, but I'd use caution with younger readers.

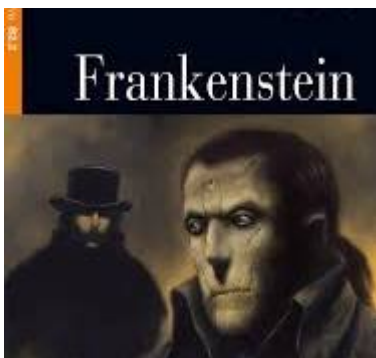


Figure Frankenstein - Mary Shelley | Graded Readers - ENGLISH - B2 ...

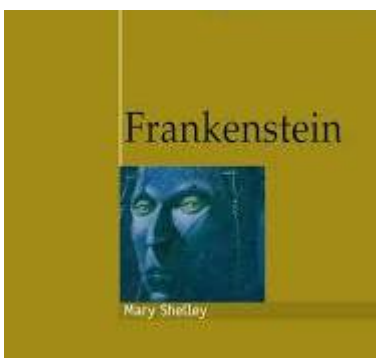


Figure Frankenstein - Mary Shelley | Literature - ENGLISH - C1/C2 ...

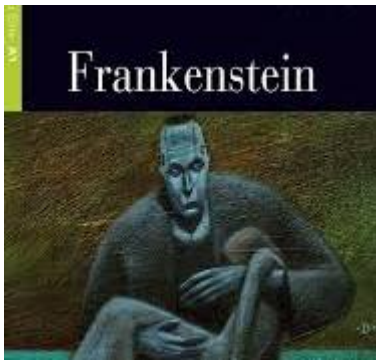
