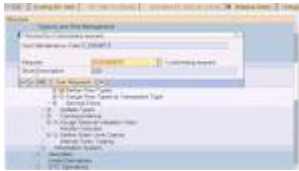

**What is the principle of axiomatic?** axiomatic method, in logic, a procedure by which an entire system (e.g., a science) is generated in accordance with specified rules by logical deduction from certain basic propositions (axioms or postulates), which in turn are constructed from a few terms taken as primitive.

**What are the domains of Axiomatic Design?** Axiomatic design decomposition (Suh 2001) involves the processing of information across four domains. Mapping occurs among the customer domain, the functional domain, the physical domain, and the process domain.

**What is design structure matrix used for?** Design Structure Matrix (DSM, also known as Dependency and Structure Modelling ) techniques support the management of complexity by focusing attention on the elements of a complex system and how they relate to each other.

Specifically, the Machines used the bio-electric, thermal, and kinetic energy of the human bodies.
