However, over this tuning range, the DFB can achieve single-frequency operation, which means that this is a continuous tuning range without mode hops.

What is a DFB chip? A Distributed Feedback (DFB) laser diode chip is a type of laser diode chip that uses a grating structure to generate a laser beam. The grating is formed by periodically varying the refractive index of the material in the active region of the laser diode chip.

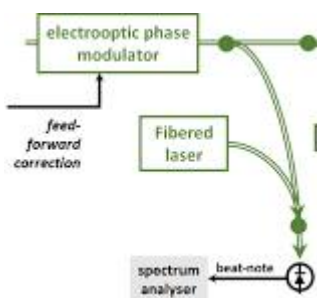


Figure Characterization of the spectrally narrowed DFB laser source ...

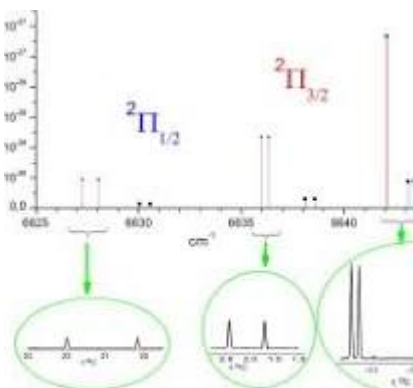


Figure Detection of vibrationally excited hydroxyl radicals by ...

How to run DOS commands? If you're on a computer with DOS as the operating system, the command prompt should appear automatically when you boot up the computer. 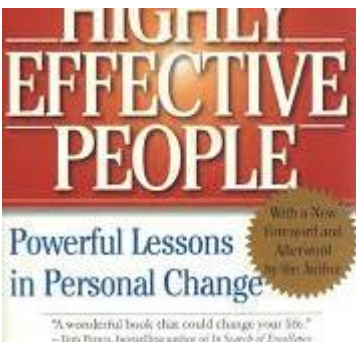


Figure The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People: Powerful Lessons in Personal Change
