What are module specifications with example? A module specification contains information about an individual module. It details the aims and learning outcomes of the module, in addition to the teaching, learning and assessment methods. So components are about the high-level design of a software, whereas modules are more about organization on the code level.

An example might be an inverter or flip-flop, which would require two or more transistors and a small number of additional supporting devices.

What is a module in software testing? Module tests, often referred to as unit tests or component tests, are used to check the individual components of computer programs. With these tests, you can examine whether individual parts are functioning correctly before they are properly integrated into the overall software concept.
