**How can you say that the performance appraisal system is effective?** An effective performance appraisal system provides consistent, reliable, and valid data to help the management make strategic decisions. It furnishes data according to the goal that serves the purpose of performance appraisal and succession planning.

**How do you make a performance appraisal successful?** An effective performance appraisal is a two-way, personalized conversation between appraiser and appraisee. It should incorporate: Feedback on the employee's contribution to individual, team and corporate goals. Setting SMART objectives for the upcoming review period.

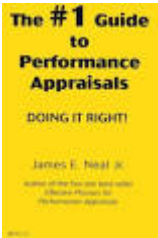

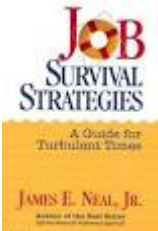

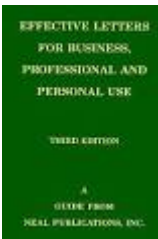

Bone densitometry technologists use a special type of X-ray equipment to measure bone mineral density at a specific anatomical site (usually the wrist, heel, spine, or hip) or to calculate total body bone mineral content.

**What should you not do before a bone density test?** Prior to the Test Do not take calcium supplements, Tums, Rolaids, Pepcid or multi-vitamins for 24 hours before your appointment. Take your other medications as prescribed. You may eat foods that contain calcium.

**What age do you get a bone densitometry scan?** Who should have a bone density scan? Women and men over 50 with risk factors for osteoporosis need a bone check-up with a DEXA scan. Younger adults with risk factors may also require a test as determined by their doctor.

Bone density scanning, also called dual-energy x-ray absorptiometry (DXA) or bone densitometry, is an enhanced form of x-ray technology that is used to measure bone loss. **What is the formula for potassium hydrogen tartrate?** Potassium hydrogen tartrate | C<sub>4</sub>H<sub>5</sub>KO<sub>6</sub> | CID 23666342 - PubChem.

**What is the solubility product of potassium hydrogen tartrate?** The solubility product constant (K<sub>sp</sub>) for potassium hydrogen tartrate (KHT) can be calculated using the equation:  $K_{sp} = [K^+][HT^-]$  where [K<sup>+</sup>] is the concentration of potassium ions and [HT<sup>-</sup>] is the concentration of hydrogen tartrate ions.

It represents the level at which a solute dissolves in solution. The more soluble a substance is, the higher the K<sub>sp</sub> value it has.

**Does higher K<sub>sp</sub> mean more soluble?** The higher the K<sub>sp</sub>, the more soluble the compound is. K<sub>sp</sub> is defined in terms of activity rather than concentration because it is a measure of a concentration that depends on certain conditions such as temperature, pressure, and composition.

**How do you write K<sub>sp</sub> value?** The equilibrium expression, K<sub>sp</sub>, is a ratio of products over reactants and can be written as  $K_{sp} = \frac{[\text{products}]}{[\text{reactants}]}$ . This expression represents the equilibrium between an ionic solid and its ions in solution.
