**What does the Apmops stand for?** The APMOPS, or the Asia-Pacific Mathematical Olympiad for Primary Schools (APMOPS), is an annual math olympiad organised by Hwa Chong Institution. The first APMOPS was held in 1990 (previously known as SMOPS) and has since expanded to participating centres in 13 overseas countries in the region.

**What is the best math Olympiad?** A six student team from India have secured the country its best performance ever in the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) 2024. **Which is the hardest olympiad?** The International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) is a mathematical olympiad for pre-university students, and is the oldest of the International Science Olympiads. It is "the most prestigious" mathematical competition in the world. The first IMO was held in Romania in 1959.

**Which country is best at olympiad?** US secured the first position, followed by China, and South Korea in the second and third positions. The Prime Minister, Narendra Modi also expressed immense joy and pride over India's exceptional performance in the International Maths Olympiad, where the country secured its best-ever 4th place finish.

**Why Singapore's kids are so good at maths?** Around the world, the Singapore method of teaching math is highly regarded because it is very effective. It is a different approach to learning math. Instead of a teacher discussing how to solve a problem on the board, students are invited to take part in the process.

**Does IGCSE Maths have coursework?** Offering over 70 subjects, IGCSEs are taken in over 120 countries. IGCSEs do not include coursework. Similar to GCSEs, they are perceived by some as academically more rigorous, and for this reason have recently been adopted by over 300 independent schools in the UK.

**What is acceptance based behavior therapy for GAD?** ABBT is firmly rooted in behavioral traditions to treating GAD (e.g., Borkovec, Newman, Lytle, & Pincus, 2002) and draws heavily on a number of approaches that have incorporated acceptance and mindfulness based strategies, including Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT; Hayes, Strosahl, & Wilson, 1999), Mindfulness- ...

**Who is acceptance and commitment therapy not good for?** ACT is present-focused, which is not suitable for addressing past traumas. While ACT does acknowledge how past experiences can influence present mental health, the approach focuses more on what clients can do in the present. For people with deeply rooted trauma, ACT may not be comprehensive enough to meet their needs.

**What is the best psychological model for treatment for GAD?** These meta-analyses further suggest that cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) is effective in treating GAD.

**What is the acceptance model of GAD?** Individuals treated with the acceptance-based behavioral therapy reported significantly fewer difficulties in emotion regulation and fear of emotional responses, as well as greater tolerance of uncertainty and perceived control over anxiety than individuals in the waitlist control condition.

**What is the best approach for GAD?** Psychotherapy. Also known as talk therapy or psychological counseling, psychotherapy involves working with a therapist to reduce your anxiety symptoms. Cognitive behavioral therapy is the most effective form of psychotherapy for generalized anxiety disorder.

**What are the 4 A's of acceptance and commitment therapy?** Ans: In ACT, acceptance is understood through the “four A's”: Acknowledge, Allow, Accommodate, and Appreciate.

**How successful is ACT therapy?** Results show that across 20 meta-analyses, 133 studies and 12,477 participants, ACT is considered efficacious for all the conditions examined, which includes anxiety, depression, substance abuse and pain. No more waiting days, weeks or even months to find a therapist.

**Is ACT better than CBT?** A meta-analysis on the differences between ACT and CBT was conducted. CBT outperforms ACT on anxiety. ACT exceeds CBT on mindfulness in the short term.

**What is the overarching problem in acceptance and commitment therapy?** The main problem we treat in ACT is narrow, rigid, inflexible behaviour. Inflexible behaviour is often under “aversive control” (motivated by trying to avoid/escape something you don't want: an “aversive stimulus”) – e.g. drug-taking motivated predominantly by trying to escape feelings of anxiety or traumatic memories.

**What is the gold standard treatment for GAD?** Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) The first-line treatment and gold standard for treating anxiety is CBT. CBT for GAD is a multimodal treatment, meaning that it includes various components that target the different symptoms of the condition — physical, cognitive, and behavioral.

**What is the new treatment for GAD?** The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has granted breakthrough designation to an LSD-based treatment for generalized anxiety disorder (GAD) based on promising topline data from a phase 2b clinical trial. Mind Medicine (MindMed) Inc is developing the treatment — MM120 (lysergide d-tartrate).

**What is the first-line treatment for generalized anxiety disorder?** First-line drugs are the selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors and serotonin-norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors. **What is thermoplastic composite in aerospace?** Aerospace thermoplastic composites typically have percentages of carbon fiber around 50-60% by volume. The ratio of carbon fiber to thermoplastic resin is tailored to achieve the desired mechanical properties and compatibility with the manufacturing process.

The result is a material that outperforms traditional metal alloys in many respects, from strength and stiffness to corrosion resistance and fatigue life.

Carbon fibre reinforced polymers, often abbreviated as CFRP, stand at the forefront of composite materials in aviation. Comprising carbon fibres embedded in a polymer matrix, CFRP boasts exceptional strength and low weight.

**What are the manufacturing techniques of composites for aerospace applications?** Typical aerospace composite manufacturing processes consist of filament winding, fiber placement, pultrusion, tape laying, tape wrapping, press molding, hand layup and resin transfer molding.

The high strength fibers are also low density while occupying a large fraction of the volume.

**How does NASA use composite materials?** Solid rocket motors and pressure vessels for fuel and gas storage are typically reinforced with composites. Composites also are the standard for ablative and other high temperature components in rocket motor nozzles and reentry heat shields dating back to the Apollo era.

**What is the most widely used material in the aerospace industry?** The main groups of materials used in aerospace structures are aluminium alloys, titanium alloys, steels and composites. In addition to these materials, nickel-based alloys are important structural materials for jet engines.

**Why do aerospace engineers increasingly use composites in their design instead of metals?** Composite materials are particularly attractive to aviation and aerospace applications because of their exceptional strength and stiffness-to-density ratios and superior physical properties. A composite material typically consists of relatively strong, stiff fibres in a tough resin matrix.

**How are composite materials changing the aviation industry?** These materials help to make the aircraft more lightweight, which in turn helps to reduce fuel consumption, resulting in energy saving. The composites also rendering aircrafts with a smooth surface, which is convenient and comfortable for the passengers as well as to the crew for manoeuvring.

**What is the most used manufacture method for composites?** Injection moulding is arguably the most widely used net-shape manufacturing process for composite materials. Bulk moulding compound is heated before being injected into a heated mould where it is held under pressure until the resin has cured.

**What are thermoplastics used for in aviation?** Reduced aircraft fuel burn, production energy efficiency and waste elimination are three main areas thermoplastic composites contribute to sustainability.

**What is the difference between thermoplastic and composites?** Whereas the forming of thermoset composites is based on solidification through chemical reactions, thermoplastics are formed through physical principles based on remelting and no chemical reactions are needed during its forming processes.

**What is an example of thermoplastic matrix composites?** Common examples of semicrystalline thermoplastics include Polyamides (PA), polyethylene (PE), polypropylene (PP), Acetal, etc. while the common examples of the amorphous include Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene (ABS), Polycarbonate (PC), PETG, Polystyrene (PS), Poly Vinyl Chloride (PVC), etc.

**How are thermoplastic composites made?** Tape manufacture, which involves the fiber tows impregnation with thermoplastic particles and their subsequent coalescence on the fibers to form a flexible prepreg tape; Consolidation, which involves laying prepreg tapes into a mold followed by heat and pressure application to form void-free composites.
