What is the 3 to 1 rule acoustic guitar? When using this technique, remember to follow the rule of 3:1 — where the distance between the two mics is at least three times the distance between each mic and the guitar.

How to choose an acoustic guitar for beginners?

Can a beginner start with acoustic guitar? The perfect starting point for those first chords and riffs, an acoustic guitar will set you up for success, providing the springboard to launch your guitar-playing career. When we started learning, our only choice was a full-size dreadnought, but nowadays, there's a huge amount of choice in the beginner market.

So you can move your familiar A minor pentatonic shape at the 5th fret down to the 2nd fret and you'll be playing A major pentatonic.
