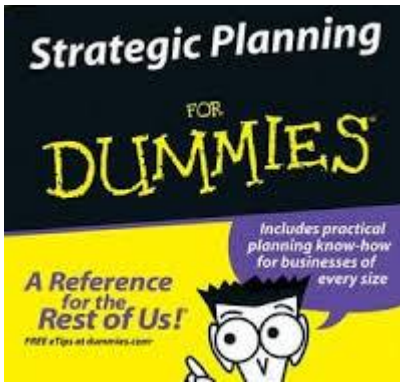

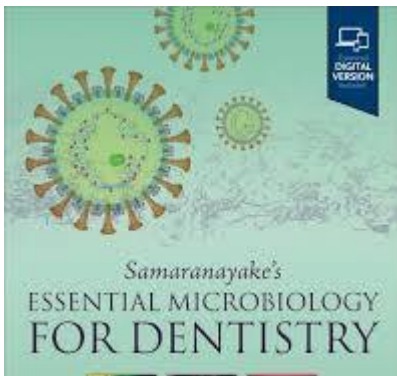


Figure Samaranayake's Essential Microbiology for Dentistry

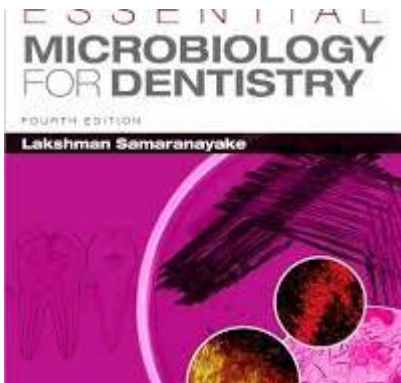


Figure Essential Microbiology for Dentistry

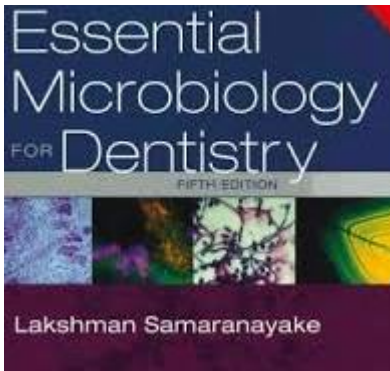
