**What are the seismic qualification levels for IEEE 693?** A standard IEEE 693 shake table qualification is conducted in accordance with one of three performance levels. The levels: High, Moderate, and Low are dependent on location and expected ground acceleration.

**What is the IEEE standard for seismic design?** The IEEE 693: Recommended Practice for Seismic Design of Substations. is a Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers standard. This standard is recognized also by American National Standards Institute, and is used mainly in the American Continent.

**What is the difference between IEEE 693 2005 and 2018?** IEEE 693-2018 is a revision of IEEE 693-2005. The current edition was changed in the following ways: “Shake-table test requirements” for qualification of bushings were modified. Conductor seismic loading effects are now explicitly included as part of the qualification of certain equipment.

**What is seismic qualification?** An important practical application of the EPSRC shaking table is seismic qualification testing of electro-mechanical plant. This usually involves shaking the equipment with simulated earthquakes to prove its safe operation during and after a seismic event.

**How do you determine seismic category?** If you are unsure of what Seismic Design Category (SDC) your project may fall under it can typically be found in the structural notes section of your construction drawings, or they may also be listed in the project specification.

**What is seismic requirements? What Are Seismic Codes?** Some provisions within the IBC, IRC and IEBC are intended to ensure that structures can adequately resist seismic forces during earthquakes. These seismic provisions represent the best available guidance on how structures should be designed and constructed to limit seismic risk.

They vary depending on the location, type, and function of the project, as well as the expected level and frequency of seismic activity.

**What is seismic equipment qualification?** The seismic performance requirements segregate seismic category I and II by the safety functions they must perform during or after a seismic event such as remaining active during or after a seismic event, maintaining a pressure boundary or structural integrity, and not failing in a way that compromises a PSSC (seismic ...

**What are the levels of seismic risk assessment?** Level 0 assessments are typically used to screen for specific risks, while Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 assessments provide increasingly detailed review, study and design evaluation.

**What are the seismic zone ratings?** Zone 1: areas least prone to earthquakes or seismic activity. Zone 2: areas that experience very little ground acceleration. Zone 3: areas that experience some ground acceleration. Zone 4: areas near active fault lines that are most prone to earthquakes or seismic activity.

**What is importance level 4 seismic?** Level 4 (IL4): Buildings that must be operational immediately after an earthquake or other disastrous event, such as emergency shelters and hospital operating theatres, triage centres and other critical post-disaster infrastructure.

**What is seismic qualification IEC standard?** IEC/IEEE 60980-344:2020 describes methods for establishing seismic qualification procedures that will yield quantitative data to demonstrate that the equipment can meet its performance requirements.

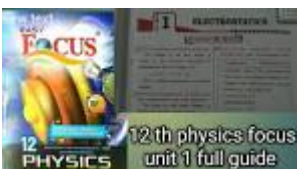

**What type of banjo is best for bluegrass?** 5 string banjo is by far the most popular type of banjo and this is the type of banjo used in bluegrass music. 5 string banjos have 4 standard strings and then one short string. The 5th string (the short one) is used as a drone when playing bluegrass banjo rolls.

**What is the difference between old time banjo and bluegrass banjo?** Type of banjo — In old-time, it's typically an open-back model. Bluegrass banjo has a resonator and is louder. Solos — Everyone just plays the song straight on through in old-time, which rarely has individual solos.

**How hard is it to play bluegrass banjo?** The 5 string banjo is actually one of the easiest stringed instrument to get started playing, thanks to its open chord tuning. I routinely go to music festivals and am able to teach groups of people who have never played any musical instrument how to play the banjo in less than 5 minutes.

**What tuning is bluegrass banjo?** The most common banjo type is a 5 string banjo and has a standard tuning in open G - the notes from the 5th string to the 1st are G, D, G, B, D.

**What is the easiest bluegrass instrument to learn to play?** Both fiddle and mandolin are extremely well suited for playing melody; their smaller size permits them to be tuned much 'simpler', making them the easiest instrument to play intuitively—in any key!

**Why do banjo players play so fast?** How can people play the banjo so fast? The secret is to play rolls. A roll is a repeating pattern of notes played with the right hand, if you are a right-handed player, and with the left hand, if you are a left-handed player.

**How high should the string be on a bluegrass banjo?** Banjo string height adjustment Normal string height on a banjo is  $\frac{1}{8}$ " above the 12th fret and  $\frac{9}{64}$ " above the 22nd fret, which is measured to the center of the string from the top of each fret. If you need to adjust your banjo's action, you will need to adjust the 2 rim rods traversing the center of the rim.

**How many strings does a bluegrass banjo have?** 5 string banjos are the most common and are best suited for playing Bluegrass and Folk Music. Most string instruments are tuned from low to high as you move across the neck. The 5 string banjo has a drone string that starts in the middle of the neck, and is tuned higher than the other strings.

**What kind of banjo do you use for bluegrass?** A bluegrass banjo always has 5 string. In this context, this type of banjo needs to be louder and more present to compete with the mix of sounds it is playing with. The construction of the banjo is often heavier with more massive parts that add to the volume and sustain.

**Is a 4 or 5-string banjo better for beginners?** Banjos with 5 strings are the most popular instrument variant. They are the easiest to play if you want to create classic and unforgettable banjo melodies and rhythms. After all, these are the traditional and all-original banjos! Every banjo maker uses the 5-string build as their instrument standard.

**What size banjo is best for beginners?** The 5-string banjo is the most popular in relative terms due to its versatility and crossover with bluegrass and world folk. it is the easiest to learn to play as in most



cases it is tuned to a 'G' chord.

**Are old banjos worth money?** Some collectibles become more "valuable" with age. Except for a few specific brand names and models, that is not true for banjos. But age does enter into it if you have someone looking, say, for a specific old-timey sound or look.

**What is the easiest banjo to play?** Most beginners are looking for a 5-string model so they'll need to decide if they want to play "clawhammer" on an openback 5-string banjo or bluegrass on a 5-string resonator banjo. Typically, beginner players are looking for an instrument at an entry-level price point. We recommend the Goodtime banjos by Deering.

**Is plastic or metal thumb pick better for banjo?** Most players use a thumbpick with a plastic pick on it to achieve the best tone. Almost all banjo players do. Some guitarists do like the thumbpicks with a metal pick on it. A metal pick will give a brighter tone.

**Do you need to read music to play banjo?** No, there is very little "written music" for banjo. Anything that is written down for banjo is 99% of the time in something called tablature. Tablature is a very easy to read number system that works great for banjo.

**Do you play bluegrass with open or closed back banjo?** Sound – Resonator banjos are by far the preferred choice for bluegrass players, as the sound of the instrument is louder and twangier than the open-back banjo. When picked bluegrass-style with fingerpicks, the resonator banjo produces a very bright sound.

**Can you play bluegrass on a tenor banjo?** Yes, if you retune the tenor banjo to match the strings of the 5-string banjo, and if you use the 5-string picking tool (fingerpicks and fingernails), you get the sound which is non-recognisable (at least to untutored ears) from 5-string banjo sound – bluegrass or clawhammer.

**What banjo player's style defined the sound of bluegrass?** Earl Scruggs is generally considered to be the originator of this style of banjo playing. Despite the assumption that he singlehandedly "invented" bluegrass banjo, Scruggs had contemporaries who used a similar three-finger style approach.

**What banjo strings for bluegrass?** Nickel-plated Steel: A good clear, bright tone. This is the most common type, especially for bluegrass banjo. Stainless Steel: This type of string has very good resistance to corrosion and can last a bit longer than nickel plated steel.
