What is the entrance test for PhD in Andhra Pradesh? What is APRCET? APRCET (Andhra Pradesh Research Common Entrance Test) is a state qualifying exam that is conducted on behalf of APSCHE by Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati. The state-level exam is the means through which candidates can secure admission in MPhil and PhD offered at 14 universities in Andhra Pradesh.
