Should a construction company be cash or accrual? For most construction companies, cash accounting doesn't work because it does not reflect the construction company's current financial condition: It gives the least accurate picture of a company's finances, and many financial institutions, such as banks, do not accept financial statements based on the cash method.

What is the accounting standard for construction? Indian Accounting Standard 11 addresses revenues and costs in construction contracts following matching concept. Definitions, application, recognition, disclosure, and loss are discussed. The appendix covers service concession arrangements.

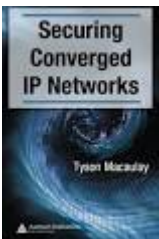

How to do lettering with a brush pen?

What do you need for brush lettering? If you want to learn brush lettering you should really use a brush pen. It's a combination of a pen or marker and a brush. The tip is flexible but the ink comes from the ink tank of the pen. This way you can concentrate on your lines and strokes much better!

What is the difference between calligraphy and brush lettering? Modern Calligraphy can be done with either a steel pointed nib or a brush. Flat (chisel edge) tip, or pointed tip. Brush Calligraphy is just that, done with a flat or pointed brush only.

What brush is best for lettering? Watercolor, acrylic, or mixed media brushes are a good choice. Steer clear of oil painting brushes, or the suuuuper cheapies - the ones that have very coarse or loose bristles.

Do you need special paper for brush pens? You can use brush pens on regular paper if you have to, but it will quickly start to fray the tips of your pens. If you want your brush pens to last as long as possible, avoid using them on regular printer or cardstock paper and instead buy smooth paper that is easier on the tips.

How to get better at brush lettering?

What is the easiest lettering style? Monoline is the easiest and cleanest lettering style to master, as each letter is written in caps and with unique strokes.

What is modern brush lettering? Brush lettering is a style of writing similar to calligraphy. With each letter, heavy pressure is applied on the downward stroke and light pressure is applied with every upward stroke. Because of the use of pressure and the appearance of the letters, brush lettering is commonly known as modern calligraphy.

What pens are best for hand lettering? To sum it up, the best pens for hand lettering, in my opinion, are Crayola Markers, Pentel Touch brush pens, Tombow Dual Brush Pens, Tombow Fudenosuke Brush Pens, and Karin Brushmarker Pros. As I experiment with more pens, I will update this post, but in two years of lettering, these have become my absolute favorites!

What material is best for lettering? Stainless steel lettering is durable and can stand up to harsh climates, making it an excellent option for external signage. One of the best things about stainless steel as a fabricated lettering material is that it is easy to work with, and it can be made in variety of finishes, such as brushed, polished or mirrored.

Should brush pens be stored upside down? Waterbased brush pens can be stored horizontally or vertically. This includes Tombow ABT dual brush pens and Pentel Sign Brush Pens. Some with double

tips like Mildliners might benefit from being horizontal but should survive being vertical too.

How to stop brush pens from fraying? Whether you are pulling your pen towards you or pushing it away from you, holding it at the same 45 degree angle will protect the tip of your pen, prevent it from fraying, and make your pen last longer! Of course, using nice, new, high-quality paper protects your brush pens, too.

How to use brush pens for calligraphy? Basic brush pen calligraphy strokes And the way to achieve this is to apply different pressure; when we draw a line up we apply little pressure and therefore the stroke is thin and when we draw a line down we apply more pressure and because of the 45 degrees position of the pen we get a thicker stroke.

How do you hold a brush pen for lettering? Angle your brush pen so it's about a 45-degree angle to the paper, not straight up and down. If you hold it straight up and down, you may ruin your nib, and you also won't be able to get the full amount of pressure.

How to write o with brush pen?

Which ink to use in brush pen? If you like working with a brush pen and water brush at the same time (so as to create shadowings and gradients) the best option is water based ink (Pentel Color Brush XGFL #101 BLACK). It's the only which dissolves completely in water, as long as it hasn't dried.

What paper to use for a brush pen? Generally, papers above 100 gsm are good for brush pen work. For best results with your brush pens, you can try the Rhodia Calligraphy Pad, which contains smooth 130 gsm paper with long fibers that make it highly resistant and suitable for ink drawings.

Is cardstock good for brush pens? Dual Brush Pens work with a huge variety of papers, including watercolor paper, mixed media paper, vellum, drawing paper and scrapbook cardstock.

What paper is best for ink brush pen?

What do you use for brush lettering? To learn brush lettering, you don't need to buy a ton of fancy pens and inks in order to master beginner brush lettering techniques. One pen will do the trick! I have a number of favorite brush pens, but there are two in particular that I recommend for newbies: Tombow Dual Brush Pens and Faber-Castell PITT Artist Pens.

What is brush pen lettering? Brush lettering is a type of calligraphy. However, unlike traditional calligraphy created with a pointed nib and ink, brush lettering is created with a brush pen (or sometimes a paintbrush) that features a flexible tip.

What paper to use for tombow brush pens? The good news is the Dual Brush Pens work with a huge variety of papers including watercolor paper, both rough and smooth, mixed media paper, vellum, drawing paper and scrapbook cardstock. They work on more papers than they don't!

What is brush lettering pen? It is a marker with a synthetic fiber tip that imitates a brush. This allows the artist to obtain different stroke thicknesses in a single movement, varying the pressure exerted on the paper and/or the inclination.

What are the tips of brush pens?

How to use brush pens for beginners? Prepare to make the upstroke by holding your pen at about a 90 degree angle to the paper. Applying light pressure, draw your brush pen upwards on the paper. Use “downstrokes” to create thick lines. Prepare to make the downstroke by holding your pen at about a 45 degree angle to the paper.

Are brush pens good for beginners? These are definitely user friendly though so are a great option. I recommend these for all beginners. They are versatile, vibrant and long lasting. Not only that, they are very user friendly and help beginners to create thick and thin lines with ease.

How do you start brush lettering?

What copy paper is best for brush lettering?

How do you hold a pen for brush lettering? If you hold your pen vertically, your brush tip will fray, which ages your pen and prevents you from getting clean lines while lettering. Trust me, you don't want to letter with a frayed brush pen!! My rule of thumb is to ALWAYS hold your brush pen at a 45 degree angle, no matter what direction your strokes are going.

What is the easiest calligraphy to learn? For those who want to start slow and dip their toe in the water that is calligraphy, monoline calligraphy, handwriting or lettering is where I would start first. It doesn't require any fancy tools or paper like some other styles of calligraphy. Just you, a piece of paper a pencil and getting right into practicing.

Do you dip brush pens in water? It's best to avoid dipping watercolor pens in water, since that will wash out the color temporarily. If you want to dilute the ink, though, that's one way of doing it! (I like to use a wet brush to lighten the color instead of dipping the marker itself into water.)

What are some myths about constellations? The constellation Gemini is said to be connected to the myth of Castor and Pollux, twin brothers, born to different fathers. Castor was the mortal son of King Tyndareus of Sparta, while Pollux was the divine son of Zeus, who had taken the form of a swan to seduce their mother, Leda.

What is the myth of Orion for kids? Orion bragged that he was a very good hunter and could kill any animal but in some myths, he was killed by the bite of a scorpion. Some stories say that the goddess Artemis sent the scorpion; others say that Orion was saved when trying to save Leto, Artemis's mother, from the scorpion.

What is the myth of Cassiopeia for kids? In Greek mythology, Cassiopeia was a vain Ethiopian queen who put the life of her daughter, Andromeda, in danger. Cassiopeia was married to Cepheus,

king of Ethiopia. She offended the Nereids, or sea nymphs, when she boasted that she was more beautiful than they.

What is the myth of the constellation Bootes for kids? Boötes, in early versions, was the keeper of Callisto and Arcas after they were turned into bears and hurled into the heavens by Zeus for safekeeping. Later, Boötes was described as chasing the bears around the north celestial pole with his two dogs, represented by the neighboring constellation of Canes Venatici.

What are some myths or legends about Orion? One myth says that Orion was banished to the sky for boasting about how many animals he would kill (to impress Eos). He and his hunting dogs, Canis Major and Minor, chase the constellations representing animals, but can never catch them. There are two legends about Orion's birth, both relating him to water.

What is the myth of the Andromeda constellation? Poseidon sent flood waters carrying a sea monster (in some versions named Cetus) to destroy the kingdom. An oracle told Cepheus that the only way to appease Poseidon and save the kingdom was to sacrifice Andromeda to the monster. Andromeda was chained to a seaside cliff to be eaten by the monster.

What is the Artemis and Orion myth for kids? One of Artemis' best friends was the giant hunter Orion. The two friends loved to hunt together. However, one day Orion boasted to Artemis that he could kill every creature on Earth. The goddess Gaia, Mother Earth, heard the boast and sent a scorpion to kill Orion.

Why is Orion's belt called Orion's belt? For example, the ancient Greeks thought that an arrangement of stars in the sky looked like a giant hunter with a sword attached to his belt, so they named it after a famous hunter in their mythology, Orion. It's one of the most recognizable constellations in the night sky and can be seen from around the world.

What did Zeus do to Orion? The creature succeeded, and after his death, the goddesses asked Zeus to place Orion among the constellations. Zeus consented and, as a memorial to Orion's death, added the Scorpion to the heavens as well.

What is the Cygnus constellation myth for kids? Stories About Cygnus One story says that the constellation represents Zeus, the chief god. Zeus once took the form of a swan to woo Leda, a human. Another story says that Cygnus was a human or a half god. He was changed into a swan and placed in the sky by Apollo, the sun god.

What is the Ursa Major myth for kids? One version is that Ursa Major represents Callisto who had a child with Zeus, king of the Greek gods. When Zeus' wife, Hera, found out, she turned Callisto into a bear. Then one day Callisto's son was out hunting and saw a great bear, not realizing it was his mother. To save them both Zeus threw them into the sky.

What is the myth of Cepheus? King Cepheus consulted with an oracle who instructed him to sacrifice his young daughter to the monster, as the only way to appease the gods. Andromeda was chained to an ocean cliff and left to be devoured by Cetus. Perseus, son of Zeus, flew by at this moment and spied the beautiful princess.

What is the mythology of Little Dipper? To most observers the constellation of Ursa Minor is better known as the Little Dipper. In mythology Ursa Minor is Arcas, the son of Zeus and the maiden Callisto (Ursa Major). Arcas and Callisto were changed into bears and placed in the sky by Zeus in order to be protected from his jealous wife Hera.

What is the seven sisters constellation myth? In Greek mythology, the Pleiades were the seven daughters of the Titan Atlas. He was forced to hold up the sky for eternity, and was therefore unable to protect his daughters. To save the sisters from being raped by the hunter Orion, Zeus transformed them into stars.

What is the myth of Corona constellation? In Greek mythology, Corona Borealis was linked to the legend of Theseus and the minotaur. It was generally considered to represent a crown given by Dionysus to Ariadne, the daughter of Minos of Crete, after she had been abandoned by the Athenian prince Theseus.

What are the myths about constellation? Constellation myths are ancient stories about the gods, heroes, and mythological creatures (serpents, dragons, and flying horses) featured in the constellations.

What is the myth of Taurus Orion? In Greek mythology, Orion is a legendary hunter. One myth says he was banished to the sky for boasting about how many animals he could kill. He and his two hunting dogs eternally chase Taurus the bull and the Pleiades sisters as punishment — never able to catch them.

What is the myth of Orion and the scorpion? In one, the oversized Scorpion managed to sting Orion on the heel (marked by the blue star Rigel), after a great battle. Gaia then took pity on Orion and placed him in the sky as a constellation, setting the Scorpion at the opposite end of the heavens so that they could never battle again.

What is the myth of Perseus constellation? In Greek mythology this constellation represented the hero Perseus, who slew the Medusa and rescued the princess Andromeda from the sea monster Cetus. (The other characters in the Perseus story—Andromeda's father Cepheus, her mother Cassiopeia, and the winged horse Pegasus—are also constellations.)

What is the myth behind the constellation Orion? Confident in his hunting abilities, Orion declared he would kill every animal in the world but Gaea — the goddess of the Earth — angered by Orion's claims, sent a scorpion to kill him. Upon Orion's demise, Zeus turned him into a constellation, along with the scorpion that killed him.

What is the myth of Andromeda and Perseus? The hero Perseus, son of Jupiter and Danaë, sees Andromeda while flying over Aethiopia and falls in love with her. He asks her parents for permission to marry her if he is able to save her; he subsequently kills the sea monster and rescues Andromeda.

What are some ancient beliefs about constellation? Greeks believed that stars were divine beings, dwelling in celestial realms and observing human affairs from above. Each constellation represented a unique figure from mythology, allowing the Greeks to weave captivating stories connecting the mortal and immortal realms.

What is the myth behind the constellation Crater? Crater is identified with a story from Greek mythology in which a crow or raven serves Apollo, and is sent to fetch water, but it delays its journey as it finds some figs and waits for them to ripen before eating them.

What are some myths and legends about the Taurus constellation? To the early Hebrews, Taurus was the first constellation in their zodiac and consequently it was represented by the first letter in their alphabet, Aleph. In Greek mythology, Taurus was identified with Zeus, who assumed the form of a magnificent white bull to abduct Europa, a legendary Phoenician princess.

What are the myths of the constellation Ursa Major? According to legend, Ursa Major was once the beautiful maiden Callisto, whom the god Zeus had an affair with. In order to protect her and their

son, Arcas, from his jealous wife Hera, Zeus turned Callisto and Arcas into bears. He then picked up the bears by their short, stubby tails and threw them into the sky.
