What are the seismic qualification levels for IEEE 693? A standard IEEE 693 shake table qualification is conducted in accordance with one of three performance levels. The levels: High, Moderate, and Low are dependent on location and expected ground acceleration.

What is the IEEE standard for seismic design? The IEEE 693: Recommended Practice for Seismic Design of Substations. is a Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers standard. This standard is recognized also by American National Standards Institute, and is used mainly in the American Continent.

What is the difference between IEEE 693 2005 and 2018? IEEE 693-2018 is a revision of IEEE 693-2005. The current edition was changed in the following ways: “Shake-table test requirements” for qualification of bushings were modified. Conductor seismic loading effects are now explicitly included as part of the qualification of certain equipment.

What is seismic qualification? An important practical application of the EPSRC shaking table is seismic qualification testing of electro-mechanical plant. This usually involves shaking the equipment

with simulated earthquakes to prove its safe operation during and after a seismic event.

How do you determine seismic category? If you are unsure of what Seismic Design Category (SDC) your project may fall under it can typically be found in the structural notes section of your construction drawings, or they may also be listed in the project specification.

What tests did Charlie take in Flowers for Algernon? A man named Burt Selden has given Charlie a “raw shock” test. Burt shows Charlie a stack of white cards with ink spilled on them—called a Rorschach inkblot test—and asks Charlie to tell him what he sees in the ink.

Who supervises Algernon's testing? In Flowers for Algernon, Dr. Strauss, a brain surgeon and a psychiatrist, is one of the supervising scientists on an experiment intended to increase human intelligence or at least mental capacity.

What is the IQ of Charlie in Flowers for Algernon? Flowers for Algernon Charlie is a 32-year-old man with an I.Q. of 68, who has struggled his whole life toward the goal of "being smart." This goal is actually his mother's obsession, and when she realizes the futility of it, she threatens to kill him.

What happens to Charlie's first inkblot test? In "Flowers for Algernon," what happens during Charlie's first inkblot test? He fails to see things in the inkblot.

Why was Charlie taking the tests? In the novel, Flowers for Algernon, the protagonist is a mentally challenged man named, Charlie Gordon. In order to determine his suitability for experimental surgery,

he is given some tests in the hospital.

What does Charlie symbolize in Flowers for Algernon? For Charlie, Algernon symbolizes his own identity and struggles. For the reader, Algernon symbolizes fate, reality, and death. Who is the villain in Flowers for Algernon? The antagonist in Flowers for Algernon is Professor Nemur, he is focused on scientific advancements and being recognized for these advancements, but these things come in opposition to what Charlie wants.

Why does Charlie hate the race against Algernon? Charlie says that he 'hates' the lab mouse, Algernon, because he can never outperform him. Moreover, we as the readers can see that Charlie's hopes for intellectual conversation and friendship may be disappointed.

What is Algernon's fake identity? " Despite the misgivings of Gwendolen's mother, Lady Bracknell, Jack is determined to marry Gwendolen, so he decides to "kill off" his fictional brother and to be christened with the name Ernest. Meanwhile, Algernon decides to visit Jack's place in the country, assuming the identity of his brother, Ernest.

Is Charlie really in love with Miss Kinnian? Miss Kinnian was originally Charlie's teacher. However, as his intelligence increases, she develops feelings for him which he reciprocates. They become a couple before breaking up, but they enjoy a brief reunion before Charlie's intelligence goes back to its previous level.

Why does Algernon always beat Charlie? At the beginning of the novel, Algernon can beat Charlie in a maze race because of his advanced intelligence.

Is Charlie Autistic in Flowers for Algernon? What disability does Charlie Gordon have? Charlie Gordon, the main character and narrator of Flowers for Algernon, suffers from a condition called Phenylketonuria leaving his IQ around 70.

What is the main reason Charlie wants to increase his intelligence? On the contrary, Charlie's reason for wanting to be intelligent is purely social: he wants people to like him. Charlie knows that his intellectual disability has cut him off from most of society, but his powerlessness does not upset him.

What pov is Flowers for Algernon? What is the point of view in Flowers for Algernon? The point of view is first person. Charlie is both the protagonist and the narrator. His journal entries show his increasing intellect as his narration becomes more formal.

Why does Charlie think he fails the test? Charlie thinks he failed the test because he couldn't see pictures in the inkblots and the man walked out. The test was confusing because he couldn't see pictures, he saw "inkblots".

What kind of test did Burt give Charlie in Flowers for Algernon? Answer and Explanation: The Rorschach test in Flowers for Algernon is a psychological test comprised of a series of inkblot images to test a subject's ability to free-associate images using their imagination.

What does Charlie see in the inkblot test? Burt wants Charlie to tell him what he sees in the inkblots. Charlie just sees ink. He tries really hard to see something else but is unable to.

What is the experiment in Flowers for Algernon? Charlie is a thirty-two year old, developmentally delayed man that undergoes a risky surgical procedure that ultimately turns him into a genius. With an

original IQ of only 68, Charlie opts for experimental neurosurgery that nearly triples his IQ after only nine months.

How does Charlie feel about the test? Charlie is given a Rorschach test which is an inkblot test. Charlie is supposed to state what he sees in the inkblot and Charlie becomes frustrated when he is unable to “see” anything other than spilled ink. The test makes Charlie feel dumb.
