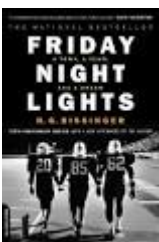

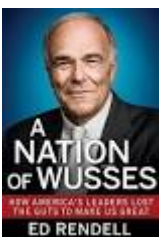

**What is a jam session in an interview?** Just A Minute (JAM) Sessions are one-minute impromptu speeches. Here, the speaker is presented with a topic on the podium and is given 10–30 seconds to think about it and assimilate all their ideas. After the thinking period is over, the individual is given a minute to express their views on that particular topic.

**What is the just a minute topic?** Just a Minute Speech is an impromptu speaking activity where participants are given a topic and have to speak about it for one minute without hesitation, repetition, or deviation. It's a great exercise for practicing spontaneous speaking skills and boosting confidence in public speaking engagements.

So, if you have the preparedness to be able to play with jazz musicians who know what they're doing, then, of course, it's super-inviting.

**What is jam in an interview?** JAM is the short form of Just a Minute. Most of companies have this round in their interview process for freshers. In this round interviewers will ask candidates to speak about the given topic for 1 minute. If the candidate can impress the recruiter within that one minute then he/she will be shortlisted for next round.

**How to structure a jam session?** Keep the first minute or two simple so that everyone can get used to the structure. Once everyone is on the same page the fun can begin. Keep your head up as you play. More often than not, one or two people will emerge as the "leaders" of the jam, keeping everyone on time and noting when people should take solos.
