How to tell the year of Arctic Cat ATV? The VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) is a serial number used to identify an individual vehicle. The VIN for each vehicle is unique. The 10th character in the 17-character VIN represents the vehicle model-year.

What year is 0 in VIN? The North American implementation of the VIS uses the 10th digit to encode the model year of the vehicle.
