You can try applying a soft heat pack or rice bag to your face for 5–10 minutes in the morning and evening and alternate with a cold pack as needed.

Then use your tongue to push your top teeth forward and, while doing that, slowly open your mouth, stretching those tight jaw muscles. Stop doing this when you feel pain. You can repeat this ten times.
